Many will recognize the new director, Lillian O. Clemons of the Indiana area, from her 10 years of volunteer service at the center.

She has served seven years a member and secretary of the board of directors and has been involved in the summer food and after-school youth programs and helped with fund drives.

Clemons said the open house and reception will be an opportunity for people to learn about the many services and activities at the center.

More than 200 children are served through the summer food program at seven sites.

The center also provides medical assistance, emergency food and free clothing for unemployed and underemployed people in the county.

"I want to continue building on the partnerships with community, business and human-service agencies that make the programs possible," Clem-ons said. "We also hope to start a computer program for youth and adults and to expand the after-school program for children."

Clemons and her husband, John, live in Chevy Chase Heights. She graduated in 1981 from Philadelphia High School for Girls in Philadelphia and in 1986 from Indiana University of Pennsylvania with a bachelor's degree in psychology.

She has previously worked with Children and Youth Services of Indiana County, Northwestern Human Services of Indiana and as a business and technical educator with First Commonwealth Trust of Indiana and ICM School of Business and Medical Careers in Pittsburgh.

The previous executive director, Iris Holtz of Indiana, has retired. She had been the director for 20 years.
